- NeXT initiative and Business Systems: get a sneak peek at how NH is transforming our human resource systems to coordinate information under one employee record (including timekeeping, scheduling, payroll, benefits, recruiting, and more).
- Home Support Redesign initiative and Community Systems: explore information about systems being implemented and used for home support, primary care, specialized community services, and public health.
- SaferCare initiative, HIMS, and Clinical Information Systems: learn how NH is
 further advancing our Cerner hospital information system and electronic health
 record. Pods include paper-to-digital health records transition and speech-to-text
 services, and how we're integrating system-to-systems and system-to-devices, and

New SaferCare Medical Staff Advisory Committee

The SaferCare Steering Committee and NH Executive have approved a new medical staff advisory committee. Eligible physicians and nurse practitioners are encouraged to apply to join by <u>submitting an expression of interest</u>. The committee will play a major role in decision-making for build content and workflow for SaferCare as we advance and further invest in the Cerner EMR (electronic medical record).

On February 12, 2024, Kitimat became the latest SaferCare SurgCare 1a site to go-live with electronic documentation.

Pre-surgical assessments by nursing are now digital in Cerner as well as documentation for Day Care Surgery, Intra-Op, and PACU. Anesthesiologists also shifted to digital documenting leveraging integrated devices.

For patients, this means they can now use <u>NH Tracks</u>, NH's digital surgical tracking tool that allows surgical patients and their families to stay updated on their loved one's surgical journey.
