The Northern Health Kidney Care Project is responsible for the delivery of kidney care across the region. The project has put together an update in the form of an <u>infographic</u> on their accomplishments over the last year and their future directions. Their strategy is to give patients better access to care that's aligned with best practices. The project gives patients with advanced kidney disease access to virtual team-based kidney care. The new centralized referral process using the <u>nephrology consultation referral form</u> provides timely access to nephrology consultations. New NH Colorectal Screening and Surveillance Guide

NH MAC has endorsed a new <u>Colorectal Screening and Surveillance Guide</u>.
