

## BC PharmaCare announced effective January 15, 2018 mifegymiso will be no

charge for all BC residents through community pharmacies and coordinated through BC Center for Disease Control.

Northern Health Pharmacy have confirmed that most community pharmacies should now have stock on hand. BC women can now obtain access without waiting and removes the need for NH hospitals to supply mifegymiso for dispensing to outpatients. NH Pharmacy will continue to provide for inpatient use per formulary policy.
