Please note that Canadian Blood Services will be phasing out Panzyga and replacing it with Gammaguard liquid. Therefore, based on availability of stocks, patients currently receiving Panzyga will be gradually transitioned to Gammaguard liquid. Gammaguard liquid has a lower IgA content and, theoretically, the transition should not cause any issues with IgA deficient patients.
