Drug Shortage Cosyntropin zinc (Synacthen Depot) 1 mg/mL x 1 mL ampoule

The Issue: Cosyntropin zinc (Synacthen Depot) 1 mg/mL x 1 mL ampoule is on backorder and stock is expiring at the end of February 2019.

Anticipated Availability: July 2019

<u>Clinical Use:</u> Diagnostic use for investigation of adrenocortical insufficiency and therapeutic use for collagen, dermatologic, endocrine, eye, hemolytic and other diseases. For intramuscular injection only.

<u>Practice Implications</u>: NH will stock out when the product expires. Supplies are not available from the vendor until the shortage is resolved.

<u>Potential Alternatives:</u>**Cosyntropin (Cortrosyn) 0.25 mg (250 mcg) vial is stocked in NH and is indicated for use as a diagnostic agent in the screening of patients presumed to have adrencortical insufficiency.

Cosyntropin (Cortrosyn) 0.25 mg vial may be administered intramuscularly, as a direct intravenous injection and by intravenous infusion. Please refer to the Cosyntropin (Cortrosyn) PDAM for administration and adrenal stimulation test dosing information.

If cosyntropin zinc (Synacthen Depot) 1 mg/mL x 1 mL is needed for a prolonged multiday adrenal function test please contact the pharmacy.
