

## **Drug Shortage: Preventative Measures**

Heparin 10,000 unit/mL X 0.5 mL vials Heparin 1,000 units/mL X 10 mL vials

<u>The Issue:</u> One of the global suppliers of heparin, China, has experienced active ingredient issues due to various reasons and this is expected to increase strain on other heparin suppliers. As such, a proactive approach to conserving the stock we have in Northern Health is recommended.

*Note:* NH has supply until end of October at the current usage rate; however, one of the primary vendors is on backorder until early October and if this is delayed further, there could be challenges with extending the current supply on hand.

<u>Clinical Use:</u> The heparin vials affected are primarily used in VTE prophylaxis, CRRT, and heparin IV bolus dosing during heparin infusions.

<u>Practice Implications</u>: Clinicians should be aware of the shortage and utilize alternative anticoagulants when clinically appropriate to conserve the heparin supply in Northern Health.

• E.g. <u>VTE Prophylaxis Order Set</u>: prescribe enoxaparin where possible on the form and conserve heparin for those that cannot tolerate a LMWH (e.g. renal impairement)

## Alternatives\*:

- Enoxaparin injection
- Dalteparin injection (formulary restricted)
- Oral anticoagulants
