

## Drug Shortage and Product Change Crash Cart Medication Lidocaine 2% (20 mg/mL) X 5 mL PFS

<u>The issue</u>: The LifeShield<sup>™</sup> lidocaine 2% (20 mg/mL) X 5 mL pre-filled syringe (PFS) products from Pfizer® are on backorder with an expected resupply date of late October 2019. An alternate needle-less product is available which will be temporarily brought in for use in crash kits.

<u>Clinical Use:</u> Lidocaine 2% (20 mg/mL) X 5 mL PFS are stocked in crash carts and wardstock locations across NH for treatment of cardiac arrhythmias.

<u>Practice Implications</u>: Crash kits will be replaced with the alternative needle-less product Ansyr<sup>™</sup> PFS (see below). This product is the *same concentration and volume* as the LifeShield<sup>™</sup> PFS. The Ansyr<sup>™</sup> PFS has a luer lock tip that is compatible with all IV systems. In order to alert staff, a backorder notice card will be placed in each cart containing the new Ansyr<sup>™</sup> product.

**Note:** Sites may see both types of PFS during the transition if they respond to codes in different areas of the hospital. This is due to differences in product turnover and expiration dating.
