

<u>The issue:</u> All NH stock of vitamin B6 (pyridoxine) 100 mg/mL x 30 mL vials are expiring on July 31, 2019. The sole source vendor has indicated that new stock will be available in mid-August 2019.

<u>NH stock status</u>: Vitamin B6 100 mg/mL x 30 mL vials are stocked in NH hospitals and health centres to treat neurological toxicities caused by isoniazid overdose as per BC Drug and Poison Control Information Centre's (BC DPIC) recommendations.

BC Drug and Poison Control Information Centre is recommending, to BC hospitals who carry vitamin B6 100 mg/mL x 30 mL vials, to not discard expired stock, keep stock in current locations, and in the rare event it is needed, to use until the vendor is able to supply.
