

Dipyridamole Oral Tablets

Issue: Dipyridamole oral tablets in all strengths (25mg, 50mg, 75mg) have been discontinued from the single source vendor with no direct alternatives available in Canada. NH currently has low stock with short expiry dating, which will not be replenished once supply is depleted.

Implications for Practice: Low

Alternative Antiplatelet Agents*:

- ASA/dipyridamole ER (currently in short supply)
- ASA
- Clopidogrel
- Ticagrelor (<u>formulary restricted</u>)
