

SITE VISITS: WHAT DO CANDIDATES REALLY SEE?

Our recruiters are very detail oriented and precise when it comes to planning site-visits for our Physician and Nurse Practitioner candidates. Below are some key aspects of a site-visit and what they entail:

- · Site-visits typically last about 3-5 days
- Recruiters plan the entire visit including: community tours, school tours, realtor meetings, facility tours, faculty meetings, and recruitment dinners
- Sometimes candidates will provide Locum coverage during a site-visit to truly get a sense of the community and facilities
- Recruiters are happy to meet candidates at the airport, drive them to their events/meetings, or let them explore on their own if this is their preference
