

Attapulgite (Kaopectate®) 40 mg/mL Suspension

Issue: After a recent drug recall affecting all stock on the market, attapulgite (Kaopectate®) 40 mg/mL oral suspension has now been discontinued in Canada.

NH does not currently have any supply on hand in any facilities.

Attapulgite is indicated for treatment of mild to moderate diarrhea.

Implications for Practice: Low

Potential Alternatives:

- loperamide (Imodium®)
- bismuth subsalicylate (Pepto-Bismol®)
- diphenoxylate/atropine (Lomotil®)
