





Hydralazine 20 mg/mL x 1 mL Injectable

<u>The issue:</u> Hydralazine 20 mg/mL x 1 mL injectable is a single source item from Sterimax who has indicated the drug is in short supply with intermittent availability.

<u>NH stock status</u>: NH has approximately six weeks of inventory and we anticipate insufficient stock if supply does not strengthen.

Practice Implications:

- Clinicians should be aware of this potential shortage.
- Clinicians should use therapeutic alternatives where possible to conserve existing hydralazine stock for high priority indications and locations:
 - High priority indications include the acute management of <u>severe</u> hypertension in pregnancy that is non-responsive to IV labetalol.
 - High priority patient care areas include the Emergency Department and Obstetrics/Maternity.
- Clinicians should step down to oral anti-hypertensive therapy as soon as clinically appropriate.

<u>Potential Alternatives (IV only)*:</u> Use parenteral therapy options where appropriate and refer to the <u>NH Parenteral Drug Administration Manual</u> for information on intravenous drug administration.

- Labetalol injection
- Esmolol injection
- Enalaprilat injection
- Nitroglycerin injection
- Nitroprusside injection
