

## Famotidine 10 mg/mLX 2 mL Injectable

**The Issue:** famotidine 10 mg/mL X 2 mL injectable is on backorder from the sole source vendor in Canada. NH has approximately 8 to 10 weeks of remaining supply in pharmacies and patient care areas.

Anticipated Availability: End of October 2021

## **Practice Implications:**

- Clinicians should be aware of this shortage and alternative options to consider if sites begin to stock out.
- Clinicians are asked to assess patient suitability for de-escalation of therapy (e.g. antacids) before switching therapy to proton-pump inhibitors (PPIs). Non-medication interventions should also be considered (e.g. avoid dietary triggers, elevate head of bed).
- Famotidine 20 mg oral tablets are currently excluded from formulary; however, NH pharmacy has brought in a supply to be used if necessary.

## Potential Alternatives\*:

- <u>Antacids</u> (e.g. TUMS®, Gaviscon®, Almagel®, Pepto-Bismol®): consider deescalation as first line option
- Ranitidine 150 mg tablets: formulary, but also currently on shortage
- Famotidine 20 mg tablets: excluded, supply available during shortage
- Pantoprazole (oral and injectable): formulary
- <u>Esomeprazole/omeprazole/lansoprazole tablets/capsules</u>: <u>see formulary restriction</u>
