





## Lorazepam 4 mg/mL Injectable

<u>The issue:</u> lorazepam 4 mg/mL X 1 mL injectable is currently on backorder from the sole source vendor in Canada. NH has approximately 4 to 6 weeks of stock in pharmacies and clinical areas.

<u>Clinical Use:</u> benzodiazepine typically used for treatment of anxiety disorders, severe agitation, active seizures including status epilepticus, and alcohol withdrawal

**Estimated Resolution:** November 2022

## **Practice Implications:**

- Clinicians should be aware of this drug shortage and potential formulary alternatives.
- Existing supply of lorazepam 4 mg/mL injectable should be reserved for use when oral lorazepam or injectable alternatives are not clinically appropriate.

## **Potential Formulary Alternatives\*:**

- Benzodiazepines:
  - o lorazepam oral and sublingual tablets
  - o diazepam injectable
  - o midazolam injectable
- Non-benzodiazepine anti-seizure options:
  - o phenytoin injectable
  - levetiracetam injectable
  - o phenobarbital injectable
