Drug:

Dihydroergotamine 1 mg/mL injectable

Classification:

Vasoconstrictor, vascular headache therapy

Indication:

Acute migraine

Duration:

Dihydroergotamine injectable is on backorder from Sterimax until mid February 2025. All supplies of dihydroergotamine injectable will expire at the end of October 2024.

Use of dihydroergotamine in NH is very low, but alternatives will need to be used after October 31, 2024.

Practice Implications:

Please reserve dihydroergotamine for refractory migraine cases that have not responded to conventional therapy. The use of alternatives should be considered where possible to preserve existing supplies. Please ensure that product is not <u>expired</u> prior to use.

Suggested Alternatives*:

- acetaminophen
- NSAIDs
- sumatriptan SC
- metoclopramide IV
