Replaces: Inpatient Doctor of the Day program and Unassigned Network Care

Program.

Schedule: Week-long assignments, Monday to Monday, with handovers at 7:00 am on Monday mornings. Flexibility can be accommodated as needed to meet individual preferences or circumstances.

Compensation: Daily stipend + Fee-for-service (FFS) or Longitudinal Family Physician (LFP).
