	Psychiatry opportunity – Expression of Interest

An Expression of Interest is requested from the Regional Child and Youth Specialized Services team for Child & Youth Psychiatrist (s). This role will work with an interdisciplinary team on the Adolescent Psychiatric Assessment Unit (APAU) within a shared care model with primary care support. This is an exciting opportunity for mentoring and growth in a specialty area, contributing on an interdisciplinary team, and working in clinical areas of interest.

APAU is a 6-bed inpatient unit for children and youth ages 12 – 18 years located at the University Hospital of Northern British Columbia (UHNBC). This is a regional service that supports both stabilization and assessment care for children and youth.

This exciting opportunity is unique as we are in the process of completing a program redesign to improve service delivery. Child & Youth Psychiatrists are key partners in the APAU program; therefore, they will have considerable opportunities for engagement and co-design during this process.

Monday – Friday with a commitment of approximately 20 hours/ week (hours are flexible) Hybrid model of care can be considered
