The Heidi Artificial Intelligence (AI) ambient scribe tool by Heidi Health has been approved for use in Northern Health (NH) operated clinical settings. The network filters that were preventing Heidi access have now been removed.

This approval for use of Heidi is based on NH completing the required Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA), Security Threat Risk Assessment (STRA) and policy review.

### **What is Heidi?**

Heidi is an Ambient Scribe tool that leverages speech recognition, natural language processing, and AI to transcribe and automatically generate clinical documentation during patient encounters.

While NH has approved Heidi for use in NH clinical settings, NH does not provide IMIT support for Heidi and medical staff are responsible for its appropriate use in clinical settings.
