ASSESSMENT TOOLS

- Screen for Child Anxiety Related Disorders (SCARED)
- PHQ-9: Modified for Teens
- 6-ITEM Kutcher Adolescent Depression Scale (KADS)
- Columbia Suicide Severity Rating Scale
- SNAP-IV 26 item scale for ADHD and oppositional behaviour
 - The SNAP-IV 26 scale is intended to be used for children ages 6-12 years, but may also be applicable to children somewhat younger and into adolescence.
 - The assessment includes forms for parents and teachers to complete, allowing for triangulation of observations across settings. Obtaining assessments from both home and school is recommended

The Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) Child and Youth Mental Health (CYMH) Clinicians can be contacted if they are connected with a youth to provide collateral and support discharge planning. Faxing a referral from the emergency department will ensure that they will follow up with the child/youth and their family.

The Compass program at BC Children's Hospital and Northern Health will continue to support hospitals by offering psychiatric assessment and evaluation for youth in emergency departments and/or admitted to inpatient units due to MHSU concerns. To access:

- Please ensure that you have medically cleared the patient and are prepared to complete a Suicide Risk Assessment, Mental Status Exam and psychosocial assessment such as HEARTSMAP (see below).
