The Northern Health Medical Advisory Committee (NHMAC) has worked closely with Northern Health Indigenous Health to draft an Action Plan to help implement the Northern Health Cultural Safety Framework. Through this process, resources have been created by Indigenous Health to support medical staff in cultural safety. This month, the NHMAC Working Group highlights some of these developments.

Cultural safety education menu

Cultural safety and system change: An assessment tool

The Northern Health Cultural Safety and System Change: An Assessment Tool document is available to support Northern Health staff and health care professionals to be inclusive and respectful of Indigenous peoples and communities in the development and implementation of health care initiatives (e.g., policies, clinical practice standards, programs, and services).

New positions

New positions have been created to support engagement with Indigenous communities and education to provide health care providers and leadership with guidance on engagement, collaboration, and partnership with local Indigenous peoples, communities, and organizations. A total of three Indigenous Community Engagement and Education Leads, one in each health service delivery area, are the "bridge" between Northern Health and the Indigenous populations and communities we serve. Northern Health Indigenous Health is also hiring two positions that will be resources to support the complaint process regarding cultural safety and/or Indigenous specific racism.
