

Physician Quality Improvement Project Update

Since January 2017, PQI Coaches have been supporting an increasing number of projects, and have since provided support to 47 physician-led quality improvement projects.



A total of 35 individual physicians are leading PQI projects throughout Northern Health, including 15 at UHNBC in Prince George, 7 in Rural Northern Interior, 7 in the Northeast, and 6 in the Northwest.

Seed Grant Application Results

The first seed grant application process has gone through. Three projects were reviewed and approved for funding by the review panel. The approval letters were sent out with some recommendations for each project. The PQI coaches will be assisting the applicants with next steps and moving their projects forward. The seed grants approved are:

- Production of Patient Education App for Colposcopy Procedure – Dr. Sheona Mitchell-Foster – PG
- 2. Shoulder Screening Clinic Dr. Paul van Zyl PG
- 3. Implementation of Routine Offering of HIV Testing in Northwestern BC Dr. Denise Jaworsky-Terrace

UHNBC Coach - Shelley Movold

- Working with a team on code pink process mapping and validation-Analyzing the process that occurs during a code pink to look for areas that could be improved upon to ensure the best care for patients.
- Working with the C-section rates working group to look at ways of preventing dystocia in an effort to decrease the number of c-sections at UHNBC.
- ERAS-UHNBC has been following a pathway of care for colorectal surgeries for nearly a year now and results are showing improvements in care due to this pathway.
 Collaborating on this project with Physicians, NH, NSQIP, and UPIC.
- Partnering with Physicians, PSP Coach, NH, and Patient Partners, on the COPD project - 2 patient journey maps have been completed to assess the need of people living with COPD and areas of improvement for health care in Prince

- George in regards to management of COPD.
- Colposcopy-Efforts are being made with Physicians, and Northern Health to create an app to improve a woman's access to information and education about the colposcopy procedure and her health situation.
- OR Booking- Working with Surgeon's and Northern Health to standardize the way in which the surgeon's book their patients for the OR.
- Priority Designation Timelines for Add-On Surgeries- Working with a team at UHNBC to review the time criteria assessed for add on surgical cases.
