



The Chief Medical Information Officer update

SaferCare Part 1 Update:

 The SaferCare project has revised its scope and timeline. The first go-live is now planned for October 2025, starting with Haida Gwaii, followed by Fort St James in November 2025, Terrace in early 2026, and Dawson Creek in late 2027.

What this means for NH Medical Staff:

- Some clinical services will continue using a mix of paper and electronic charts (Perinatal/Maternity, Oncology, Dialysis and clinical services that receive referrals).
- The HealthElife patient portal will focus on expanding enrollment and use of current features.
- Integration efforts will focus solely on Pharmanet for better medication history and reconciliation.
- The initial phase of implementation will enable advanced clinical documentation at NH's new hospital builds.
