About DMO

The Dragon Medical One (DMO) voice recognition solution is available for medical staff to complete dictated clinical documentation in EMRs and is a key strategy for supporting clinical documentation in the SaferCare project.

DMO is a cloud-based software that provides clinical speech recognition for acute, community and primary care services, instantly transcribing voice recorded notes into clinical documents.

Currently, it is available to physicians, residents, nurse practitioners and duty to accommodate staff, but roll out to other clinical staff is expected soon.

Copies To / Carbon Copy (cc) functionality will soon be implemented in Cerner and physicians will be able to add cc's to clinical and dynamic documents. Estimated date of implementation is June 2024.





DMO access and training

Northern Health physicians, residents, and nurse practitioners are given an account for DMO as part of the clinical staff onboarding process and access is provided upon completion of training. New medical staff that have not received training can request it by contacting the Service Desk.
